Instructions for the Preparation of Posters

General Information

Please note: the poster programme will be splitted into **3 sessions**:

→ **Poster Session A on Monday, 25 September 2017, 13:30 to 14:45**

P 001 - P 059, P 82

Posters of session A should be mounted until Monday, 25 September 2017, until 9:00 and to be removed at the end of the day.

The opportunities to present the posters are during all breaks on Monday and the poster session A.

→ **Poster Session B on Tuesday, 26 September 2017, 13:45 to 15:00**

P 060 - P 109, P 141, P 142, P 143

Posters of session B should be mounted on Tuesday, 26 September 2017, until 9:00 and to be removed at the end of the day.

The opportunities to present the posters are during all breaks on Tuesday and the poster session B.

→ **Poster Session C on Wednesday, 27 September 2017, 13:45 to 15:00**

P 110 - P 166

Posters of session C should be mounted on Wednesday, 27 September 2017, until 9:00 and to be removed at the end of the day.

The opportunities to present the posters are during all breaks on Tuesday and the poster session C.

The authors are asked to be at their posters during their respective poster sessions in order to answer questions and provide further information.

Important: please remove your poster in the evening of your poster session, until 18:00.

Poster Awards

Poster Prizes will be awarded at the end of the conference. The award ceremony will take place within the closing remarks on Wednesday, 27 September 2017, from 17:30.

Technical Information

Each poster will be in the size of **0,85 m width** and **1,2 m height (DIN A 0, portrait format)**. The **poster number** is mounted on top of the board.

The **author's name and address** and the **title of the paper** are to be indicated on the top section of the poster.

Material for attaching the posters will be supplied by the organisers. Writing or painting on the poster board is not allowed.

Preparation of the Poster:

As a major guideline it is proposed to make the poster intelligible in itself, even in the absence of the author. It is suggested to divide the contents of each poster into **introduction, results** and **conclusions**, with a summary listing the pertinent results and conclusions.

The poster should be legible from a distance of 2-3 meters. Therefore, the **minimum size** should be:

- 20 cm for graphs;
- 3 cm for the paper's title and the names/addresses of the authors in the heading label;
- 1,5 cm for sections headings such as introduction, results, labeling of figures and tables;
- 0,8 cm characters in height for further text.

Line spacing: 1,1 cm at minimum; 10 of such lines correspond to one figure.

Please use colours, symbols and schemes for improved clarity.

Instructions for Poster-Authors

The standard size for all posters is 0.85 x 1.2 m (DIN A 0-German Standard) vertically orientated as shown below.
